The students use the application Action bond created by German students to improve digital skills. Visit of the Skyline "Main tower".
Day 3 14-11-2023	Group activities at school to encourage internationalisation exchange in the learning of new skills and environmental education. Visit of the exhibition "The migration" City tour with the association "City walker"
Day 4 15-11-2023	Activities at school to improve cooperative learning initiatives, foreign languages (French, English and German) Visit to the Memorial Frankfurter Grossmarkthalle and the BCE. Commemoration of the deportation of Jews from Frankfurt during the second World War.
Day 5 16-11-2023	Group work students are divided into small groups to share ideas and proposals about the main topic Visit to the Historical Museum and the main historical monuments of the city to improve the knowledge of local environments. During the visit, the Italian students observed the good practices concerning the environmental education.
Day 6 17-11-2023	Workshop at Anne Frank's House using multimedia tools to improve the knowledge to historical events and the topics of inclusion, racism and migration. Erasmus party at school. Sharing of good practises, acquisition of new personal skills and attitudes on sustainable development.

Activity 2: Presentations of the meeting themes and visit the city centre

They were supervised by their teachers. They present their achievements orally in front of their peers.</p> <p>The guided visit to the city centre allowed the students to observe the most important spaces of the city of Frankfurt, to understand historical aspects, to recognize historical buildings.</p>
Learning outcomes:	<p>Reception and interpretation of concepts, ideas, opinions, feelings expressed orally or in writing in various contexts, including intercultural communication.</p>

Activity 3: Cultural visit

Learning methods:	<p>Students have a guided tour of several areas of the city. Each space is apprehended with its particularities.
